Research Experience

I have published 33 articles in scientific journals. From them, 27 articles are published in journals indexed in the *Journal Citation Reports*, and 17 are articles published in Q1 Journals as: ENERGY ECONOMICS, TRANSPORT POLICY, ENERGY POLICY, ENVIRONMENTAL POLITICS, RENEWABLE & SUSTAINABLE ENERGY REVIEWS, JOURNAL OF CLEANER PRODUCTION, LAND USE POLICY, ENERGY, APPLIED GEOGRAPHY and TRANSPORTATION. The other 6 articles are published: 1 in a scopus indexed journal and 5 in spanish national journals indexed in Econlit and Latindex, all of them in high positions.

I also have three book chapters published, two of them published internationally by Springer-Verlag Berlin Heidelberg (2013) and by InTech (2016), and the other published nationally by Delta Publications.
